PROJECT SUMMARY

The **Town of Lee** is working with the **Strafford Regional Planning Commission (SRPC)** to develop a comprehensive plan for resource management and land use that balances community interests, integrates local and regional goals, and is based on the most up to date and best available science. The end result will be a **Natural Resource Inventory (NRI)** that reflects current data and high value land use management priorities. This document will support **proactive land use planning & decision-making** in Lee.

The project seeks to **identify** Lee's critical natural resources, **build consensus** among community members around management approaches, and **create** an implementation plan.

WHAT WILL THE END RESULT BE?

The end result will be an NRI report that includes maps and data such as: Water Resources, Wildlife and Habitats, Farmlands, Forest Resources, Unique Geological Resources, Cultural & Historic Resources and Conservation Lands and Land Use.



HOW WILL THE PROJECT ADDRESS PRIORITIES & NEEDS IDENTIFIED BY THE COMMUNITY?

The NRI will be a valuable resource that can be utilized by the Board of Selectmen, Conservation Commission, Planning Board, municipal staff, residents, and business owners when planning for future land uses that balance community interests and integrate local and regional goals.
